WORK PACKAGE 1

Development and implementation of participatory Ecosystem-based Adaptation (EBA), Climate-smart Agriculture (CSA) and climate risk management measures for poor households in vulnerable districts of Ha Tinh province, Viet Nam.

ISSUE

Ha Tinh Province in central Viet Nam is facing multiple challenges on its development pathway. Agricultural livelihoods are constrained by difficult climatic conditions: prolonged drought and hot dry winds during early summer, tropical storms and flooding in autumn, and cold drizzle in winter.

With an increasingly erratic climate, many hazards are expected to intensify and become more frequent, putting rural and urban livelihoods and ecosystems under pressure.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

EBA/CSA

Improve the adaptive capacity and livelihoods of female and male farmers in Ha Tinh through implementation of EbA/CSA (Ecosystem-based Adaptation, Climate-Smart Agriculture) measures as well as gender-sensitive intensification approaches.

SCALE UP

Increase scale through the governmental systems and others: Develop the necessary capacities of stakeholders for integration of EbA/CSA into programs and strategies.



Implementation

Direct beneficiaries: 1250 households
Indirect beneficiaries: >10,000 people
