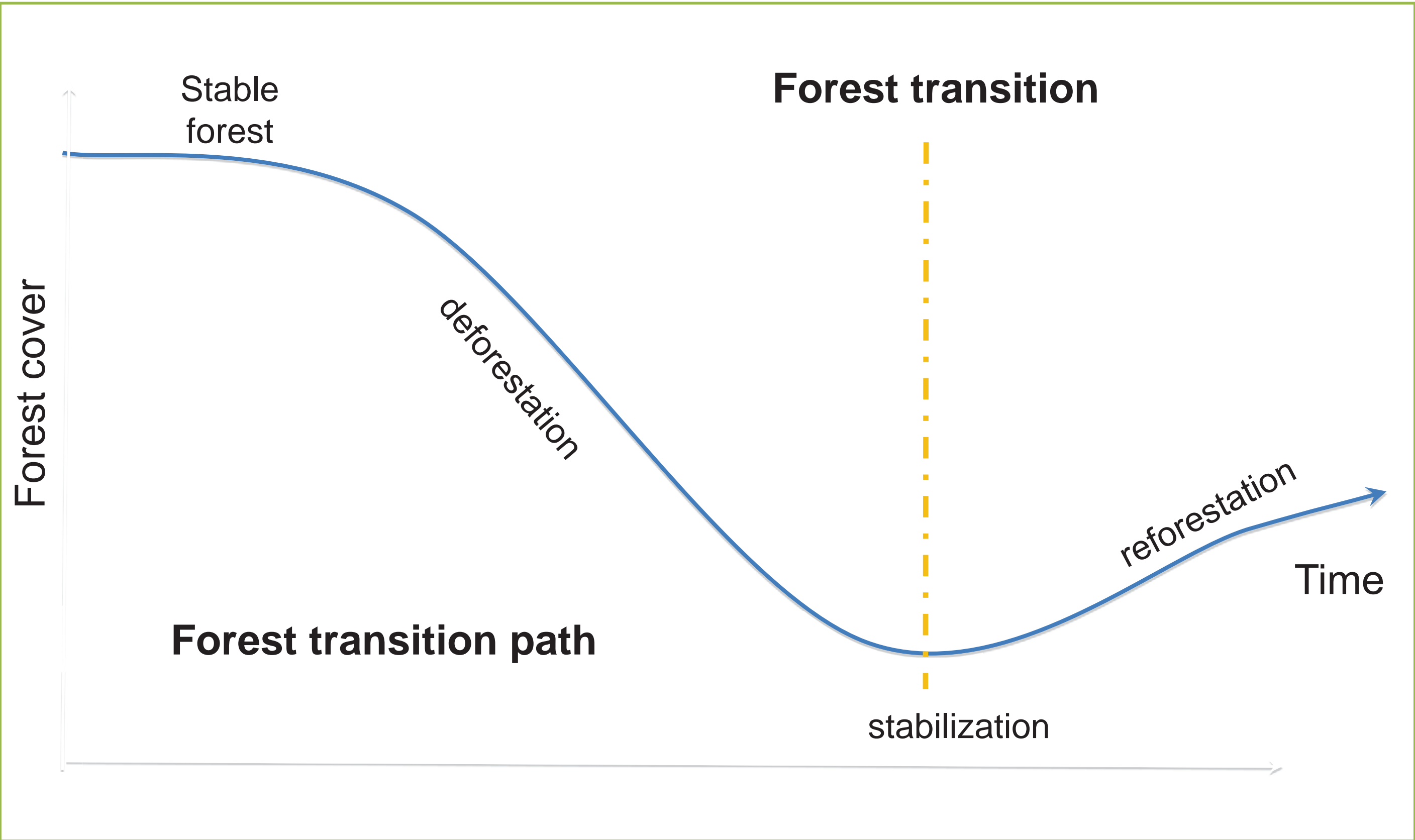




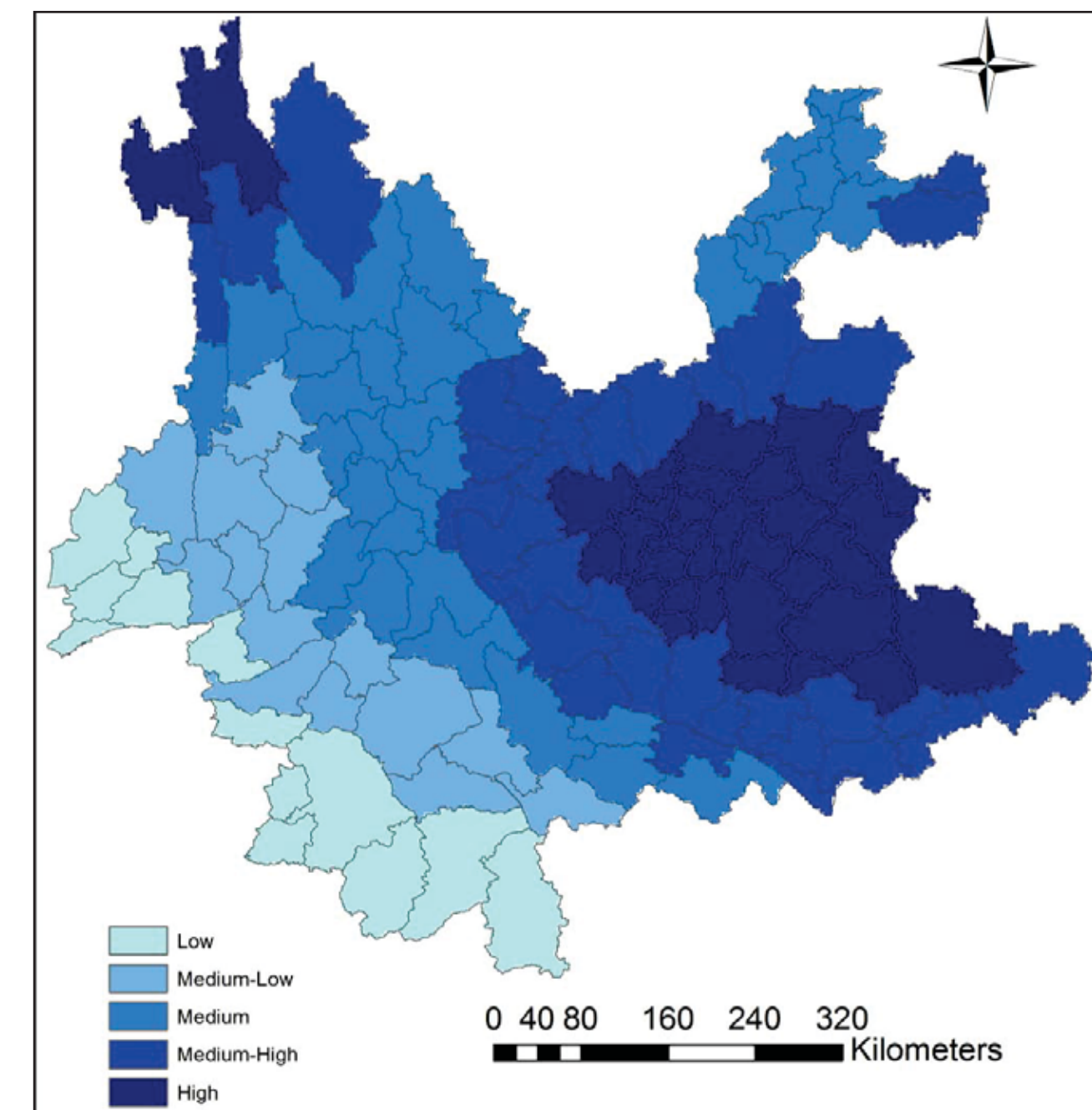
Tree cover transitions in space and time

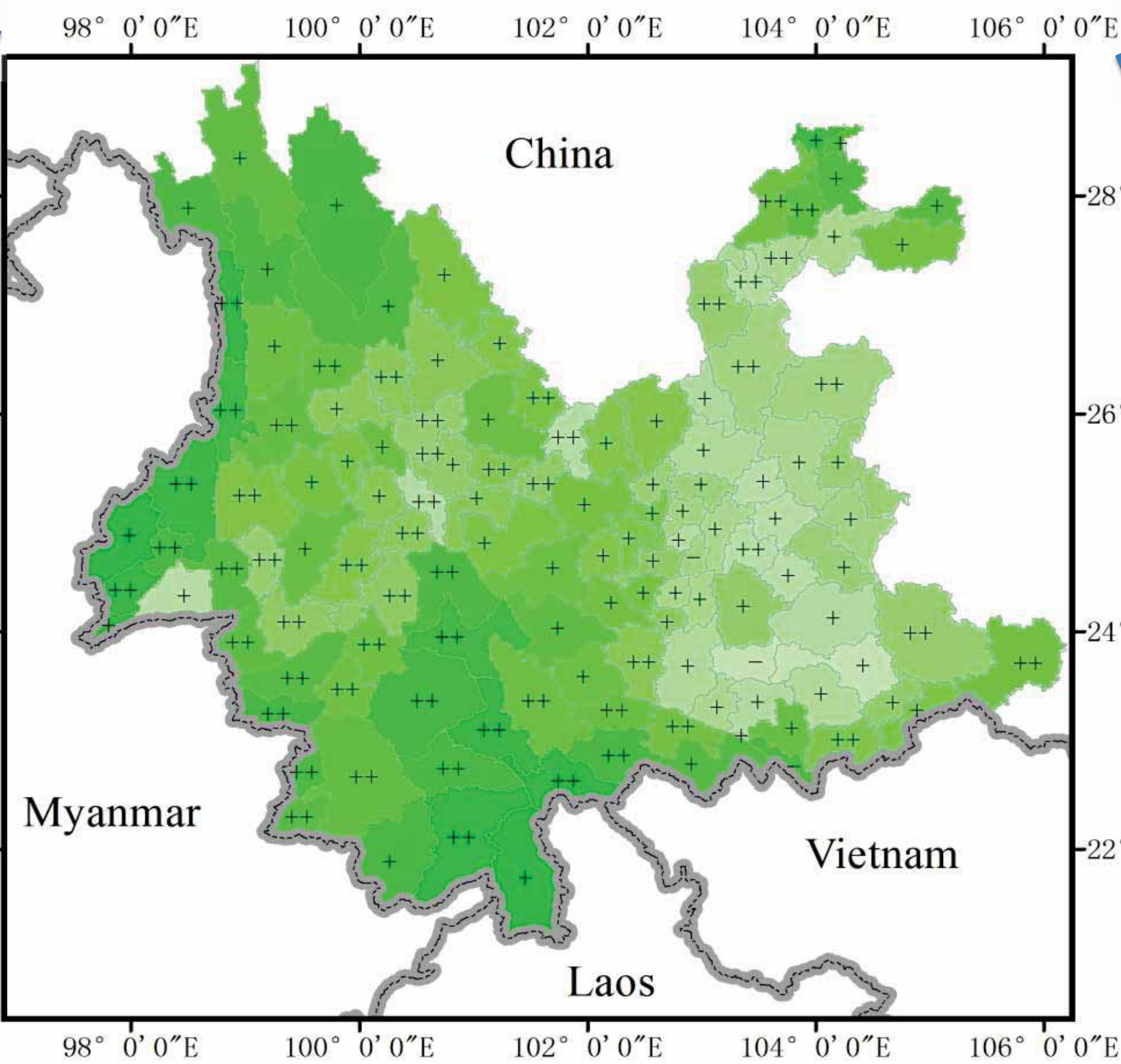

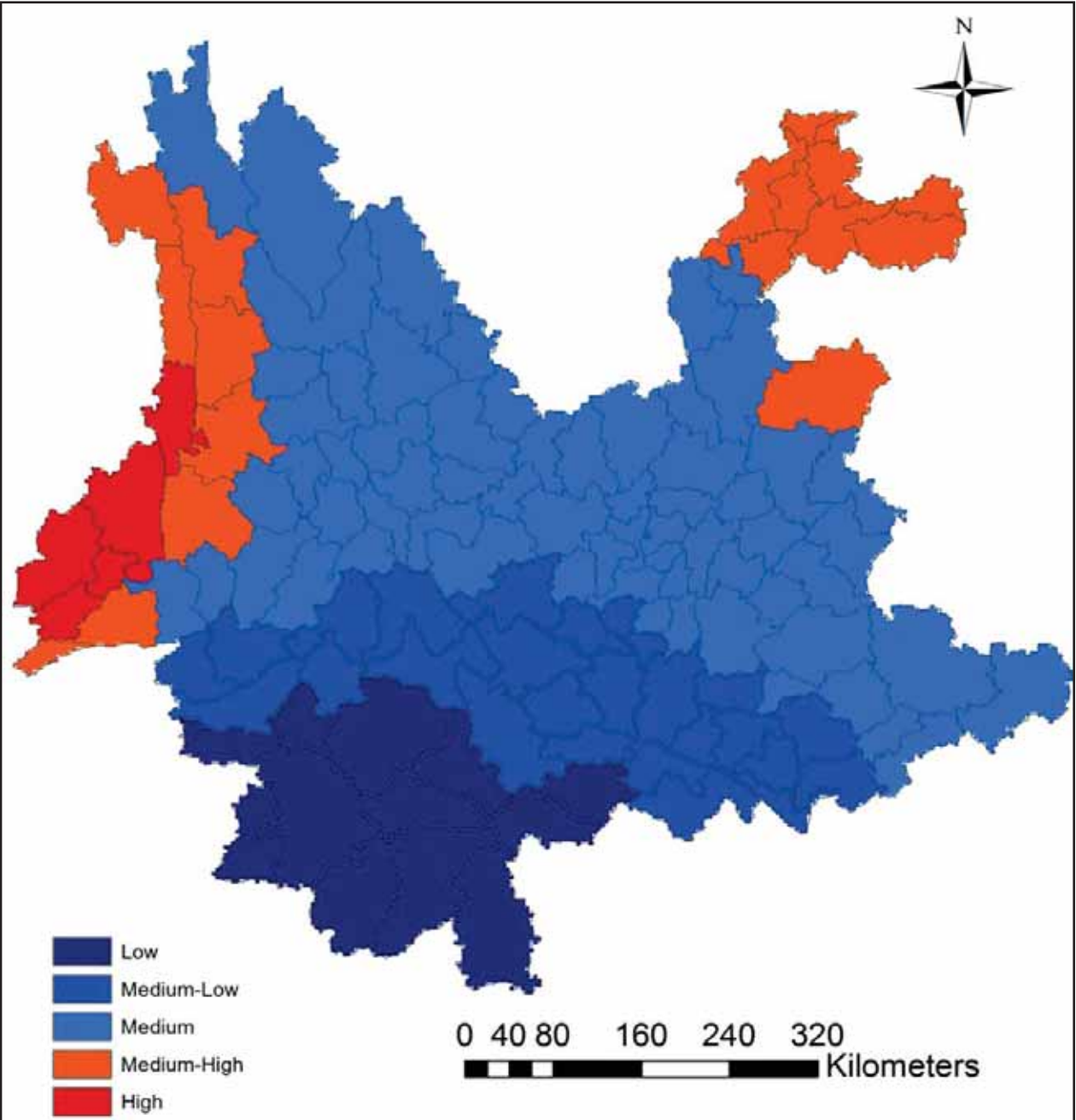


In Yunnan Province, forest re-growth increased from 23% in 1990 to 48% in 2007; Darker green represents higher forest cover

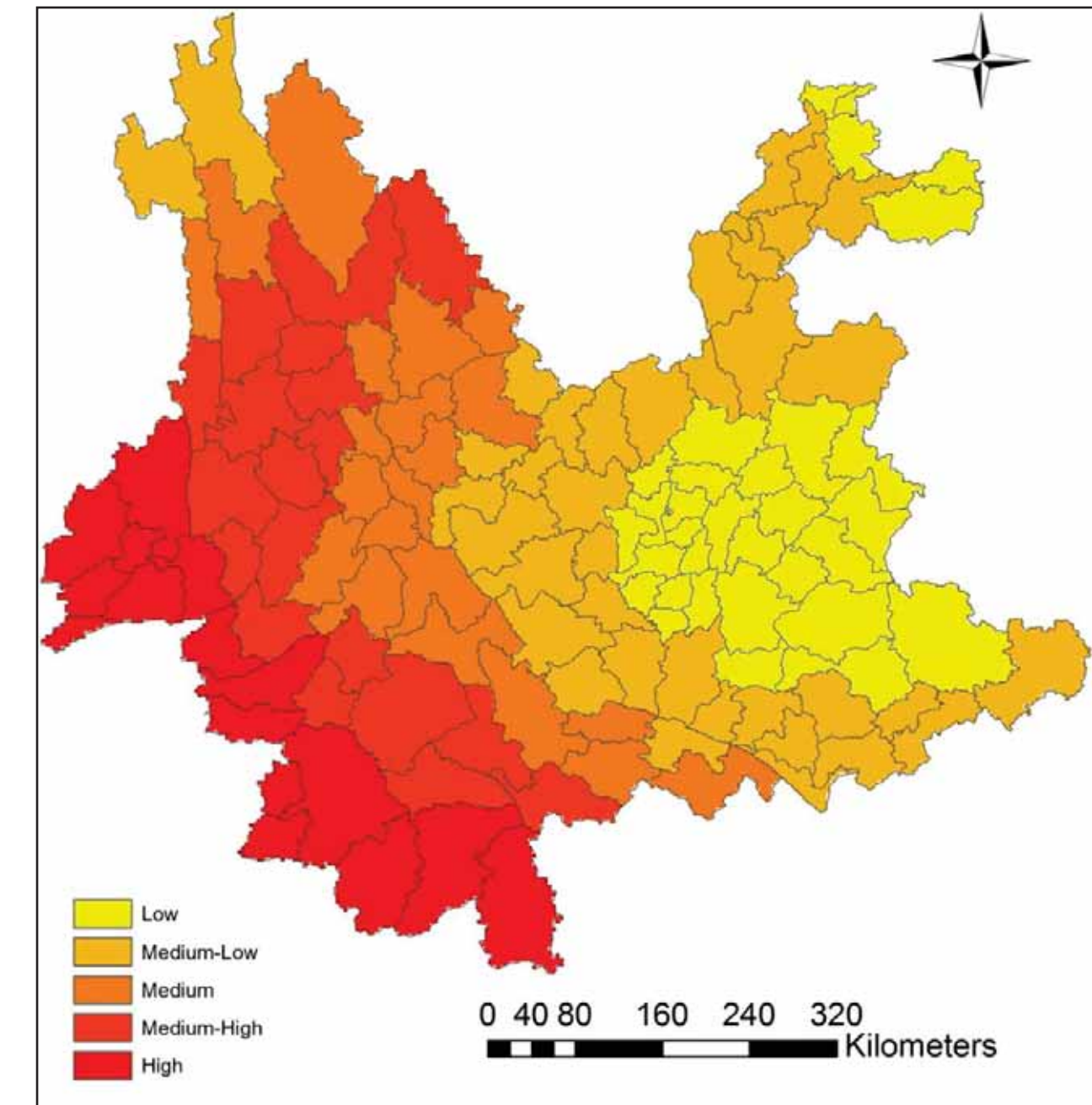
Linking forest and demographic transitions of each county in Yunnan



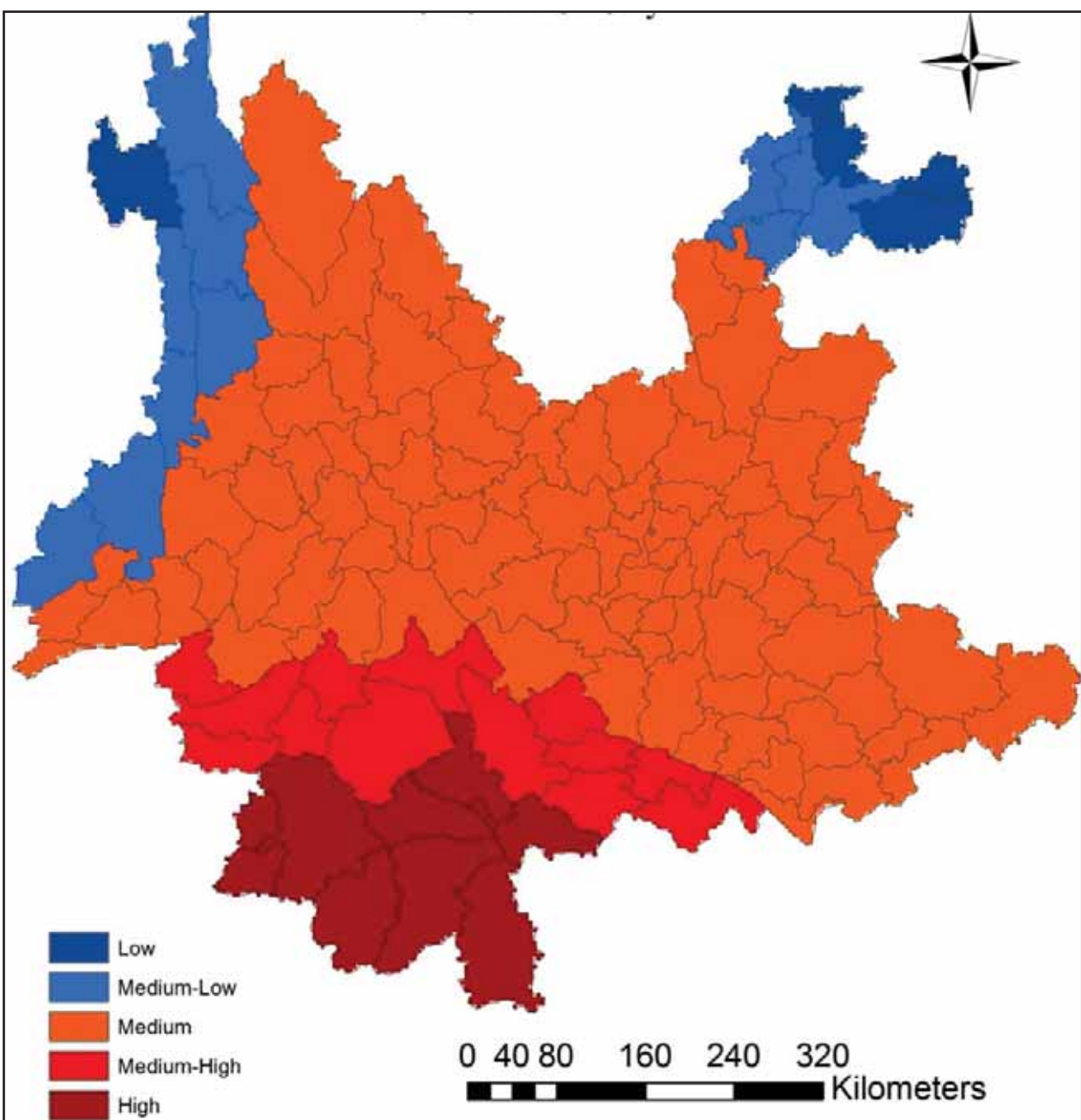
Gross Regional Products



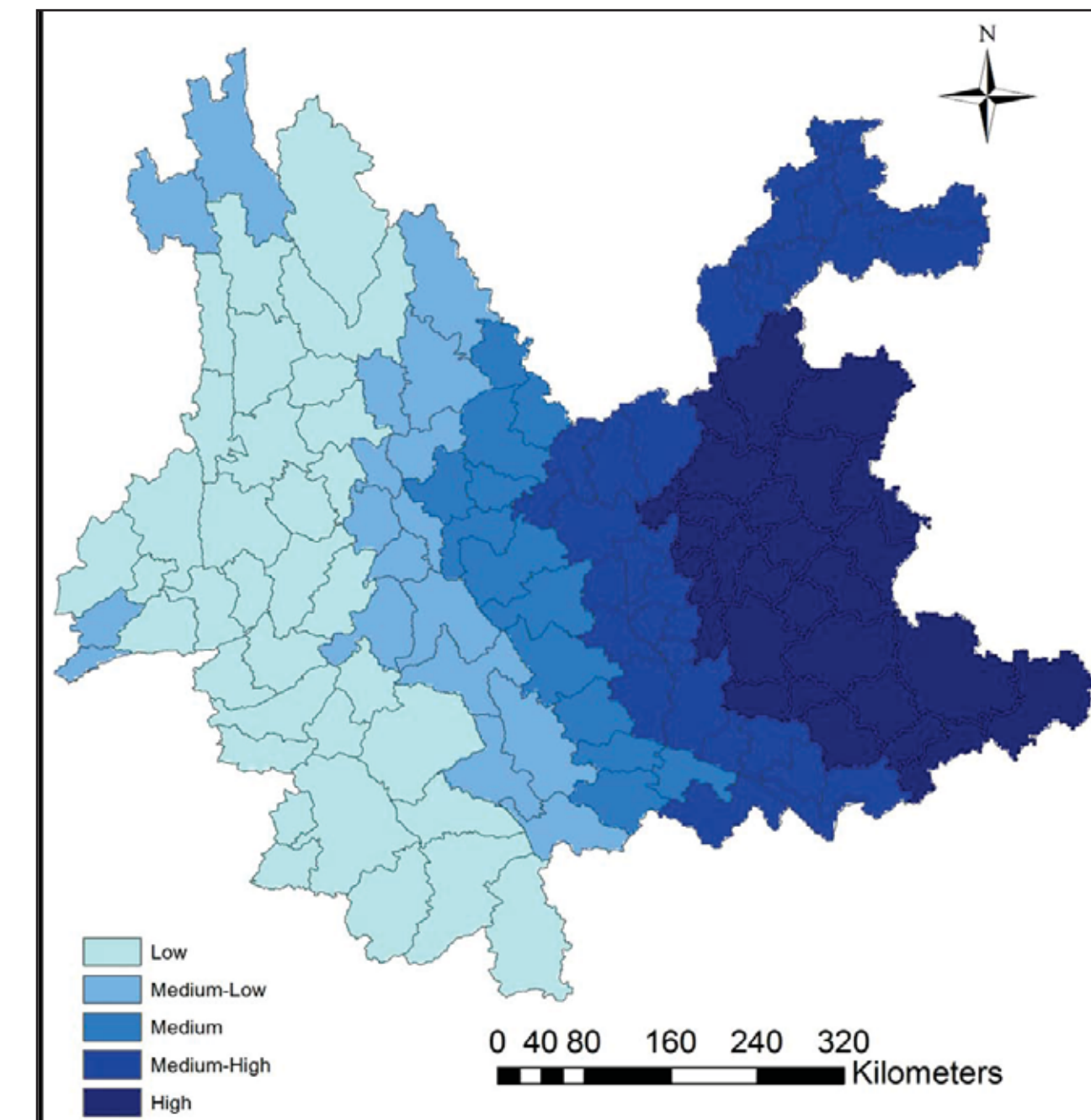
Gross Regional Products per capita



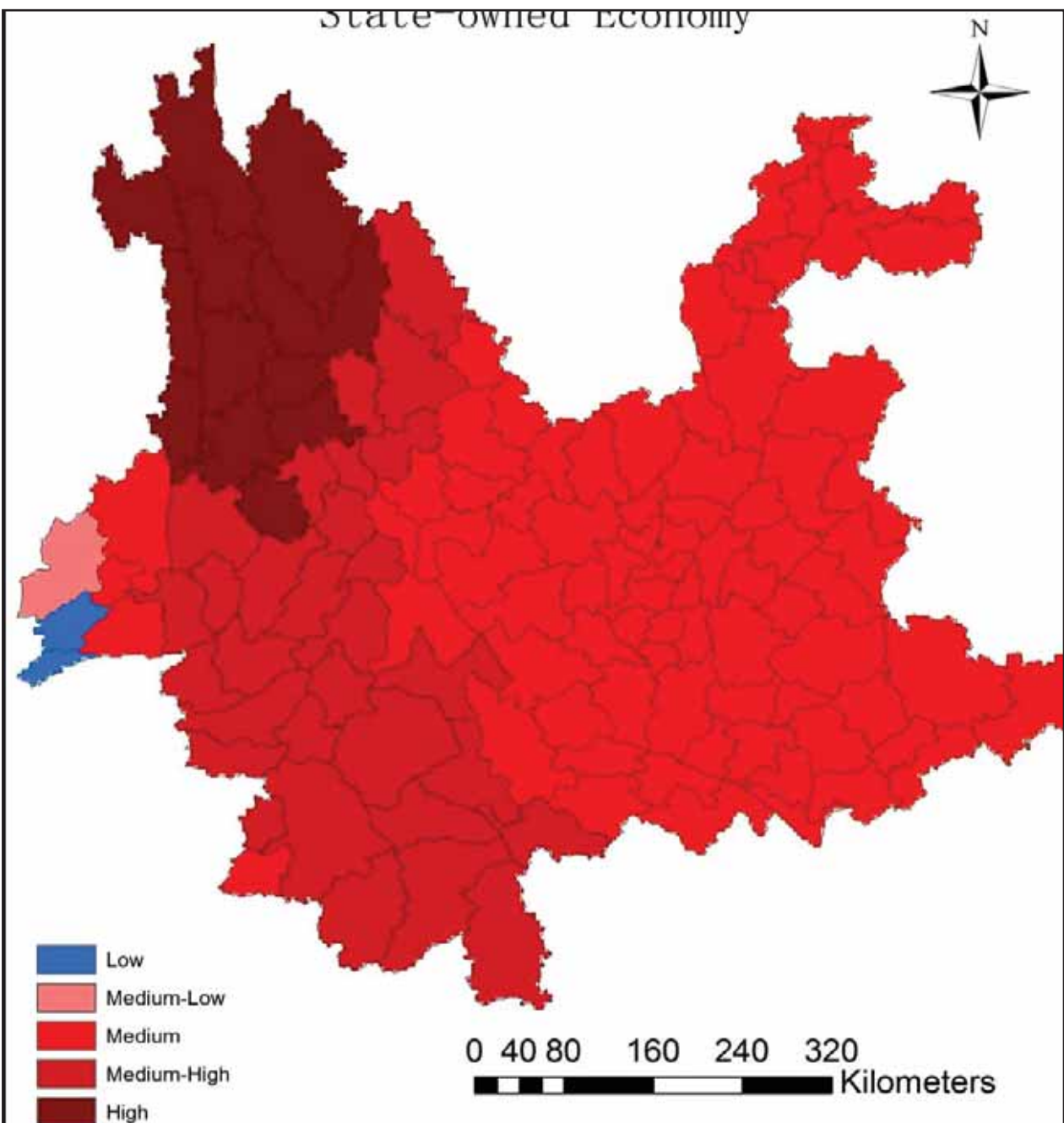
Gross output value of farming, forestry, Animal husbandry and fishery.
