Development

- Under the Presidential Proclamation No. 468, the watershed was proclaimed a forest reserve. This has been mainly to minimize slash-andburn agriculture.
- Residential School Forest and Forestry Project improves the youths' perception of trees, their importance and the ecosystem services they could provide. Cash incentives for planting trees on residence increases appreciation of trees for family nutrition.

to Climate Change

- Small farm reservoir construction improves the water delivery services as well as regulates excess water for farm.
 LGUs encourage planting of trees along the shore to minimize water loss.
- Contour farming enhances water retention and minimizes soil erosion using trees.
