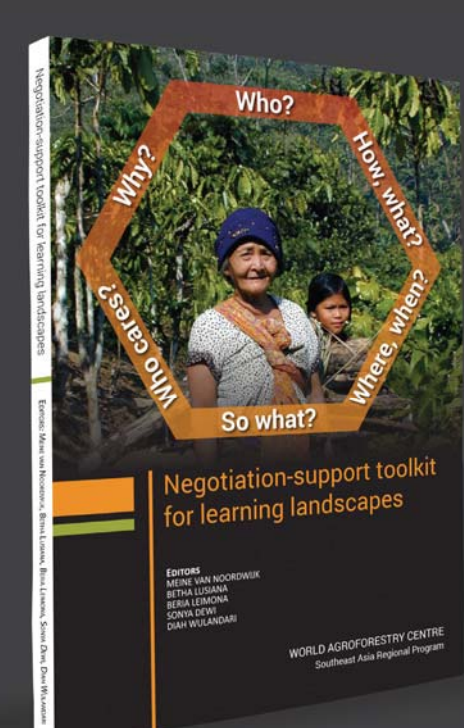

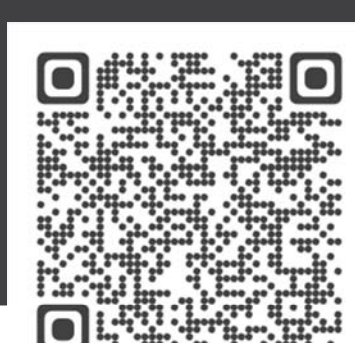
Scientific tools and methods to help you understand a landscape and negotiate changes with multiple stakeholders
