Description:

Type I Two pronounced season which is dry from November to April and wet during the rest of the year

Type II No dry season with pronounced maximum rainfall from November to January

Type III No pronounced maximum rain period and a short dry season. It is relatively dry during the period from December to April and wet period during the rest of the year

Type IV No pronounced maximum rain period and no dry season. More or less distributed rainfall throughout the year.
